Anna Lee Fischer, nee Prater, 83, of Sycamore, IL, born October 5, 1939, in Belleville, IL, died Thursday, February 2, 2023 at her home in Sycamore, IL. Anna Lee spent the first 62 years of her life in Millstadt, IL where she married her husband, Stanley, on June 20, 1959. Anna Lee was an active member of Zion Evangelical Church. She was a member of the Millstadt Civic Club and a volunteer for years at the Millstadt Library. She taught 3rd grade at Millstadt Consolidated School and 5th grade at St. James Catholic School for a total of 22 years.
