

Zion Evangelical Church Meeting Minutes - June 13, 2022

A CD came due at the bank which was for \$10,000.00; it was decided to renew for 3 months and then decide what to do with it hoping interest rates would be coming up. Rich made a motion and 2nd by Earl Doerr to approve the report. It was reported the mileage rate is \$0.625 as of July 1, 2022. Amanda will be off of work from July 18- 31 for a vacation planned before being hired at Zion.

Minutes were approved as presented. Rich motion and Kurt seconded to approve minutes motion carried.

BCE Report The Sunday School teachers would like to see summer vacation start on Memorial Day since there are no children on that attend on that Sunday . Council approved that suggestion. There were 38 children for Vacation Bible School. There had been a Vacation Bible School at St. James school the week before so a lot of the children we normally have attended at St. James. Annette made a motion and seconded by Earl to approve the report, motion carried.

Pastor Report Around one hundred members attended the church picnic. Pastor reported that we had a great yard sale making around \$5000.00 . The 6th grade class from MCS visited church on their field trip and toured the church. The Pre-School graduation was very well attended with over 100 persons in attendance. Pastor and Marjie hosted The EA Pastors and wives at Zion for a luncheon and meeting fifteen were able to attend get to know each other since there were new Pastors that have just joined. Pastor and Marjie will be camping June 23 – 27 at Twin Rivers Campgrounds in Missouri with their families. Pastor Dawson Miller will be doing the church service on June 26 at the park. Rich made a motion and Kurt second motion carried.

Renewing Zion Church We need to continue our reach and least active young families. Need to work on Advertising events. A Contemporary Worship Team has been formed with Mark and Kelly Riemann, Stacy Woelke, and Sue Hoffelmeyer. Thank these members for stepping forward to serve on this committee.

Audit and Budget Rich Hoffelmeyer reported that a line item for the Hecke Property will be made; the property has been sold for \$84,036.76 and everything was cleaned out of the shed. Earl is working on getting a building permit for the new shed at the park, getting a zoning variance and building permit. We have a put a down payment of \$13,000.00 to BuiltMor building.
